


Psalm 95:1-3, 6-8

THE SAVIOR WE NEEDED ... *For the Lord is the great God, the great King above all gods. Psalm 95:3*

Like your children the Israelites, I want to be planted in the land of promise, not led through the desert of doubt. When the escapees from Egypt got to the Red Sea, they felt trapped. Looking ahead, they saw death by drowning; looking back they saw death by Pharaoh’s army. But when they chose to die in obedience, they received life. When you were hanging on the cross, it looked as if you were trapped. To stay on the cross meant death for you; to come down would have meant death for us. But when you chose to die in obedience, we received life. Instead of saving yourself by coming down from the cross, you chose to save us by rising from the grave. Hallelujah! Thank you for becoming what the entire world needed—a Savior—rather than what one nation wanted—a king. We humbly acknowledge you as our risen Savior, and we joyfully anticipate the day when we will be able to crown you as our matchless King.”
